**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 2.01
OF THE GYPSUM MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE FOR THE
APPOINTMENT OF A MUNICIPAL COURT PROSECUTOR
BY THE TOWN MANAGER**

WHEREAS, the Town of Gypsum (“Town”) is a home rule municipality duly organized and existing under Articles XX of the Colorado Constitution and the Town’s Home Rule Charter effective October 21, 1982; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.01 of Title 2 of the Gypsum Municipal Code relates to the Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires for the Town Manager to have the authority to appoint a Municipal Court Prosecutor.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Gypsum, Colorado that:

Section 1. Adoption of Section 2.01.185 to Chapter 2.01 of Title 2 of the Gypsum Municipal Code. A new Section 2.01.185 to Chapter 2.01 of Title 2 of the Gypsum Municipal Code is hereby adopted to read as follows:

2.01.185 - Appointment of municipal court prosecutor.

The Town Manager may appoint a municipal court prosecutor, which may be the same or separate from the Town Attorney appointed pursuant to Section 9.1 of the Gypsum Town Charter.

Section 2. Amendment of Section 2.01.190. Section 2.01.190 of the Gypsum Municipal Code is hereby amended to change all references to the “city attorney” to read “municipal court prosecutor”.

Section 3. Public Inspection. Copies of this ordinance and the Gypsum Municipal Code are available for public inspection at the office of the Gypsum Town Clerk.

Section 4. Public Hearing. A public hearing on this Ordinance shall be held on the 9th day of January, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. at the Town of Gypsum Town Hall, 50 Lundgren Boulevard, Gypsum, Colorado.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective as a permanent Ordinance five (5) days after publication, following final adoption after a public hearing held on the 23rd day of January, 2018, at 7:00 p.m., at the Gypsum Town Hall, 50 Lundgren Blvd., Gypsum, Colorado.

Section 6. Severability. If any portion of this Ordinance, or the International Codes amended hereby, is found to be void or ineffective, it shall be deemed severed from this Ordinance and the remaining provisions shall remain valid and in full force and effect.
