**Easter Egg Hunt**—Hunt for eggs in at the Lundgren Theater Park. Free event for children 2-12 yrs. old. Proudly sponsored by the Town, Gypsum Rec. Center and local businesses.

**Gypsum Daze** - The event begins Friday with a talent show, fishing at Gypsum Ponds and on Saturday the Gypsum fire department's pancake breakfast, our hometown parade, food/crafts, a Jalapeño eating contest, and culminates with a big name country concert on Lundgren Theater lawn. Truly a small town celebration geared toward families and our locals. Small Town = Big Fun.

**Lundgren Amphitheater**— “Party in the Park”, community theater and special events all year long. Watch our website for more information and details.

**Snow Removal** - The Town of Gypsum plows all Town streets except for State Highway 6. All property owners are responsible for keeping their sidewalks clear of ice and snow.

**Animal Control** - The Town of Gypsum contracts with Eagle County Animal Control to help with controlling nuisance animals. Their phone number is 328-3647. Animal Control Violations are paid to the Town of Gypsum.

**On-Street Parking** - On-street parking is not allowed on Town streets Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. and on trash or snow days. Signs are posted at every street entrance. Parking tickets are \$75.00 and are reduced to \$37.50 if paid within 20 days.

Parking permits for a maximum of two (2) guest cars at a time for a period not to exceed fourteen (14) days will be issued for a residence as many as two (2) times annually. Free parking permits are available from Town Hall if you need to use the Town streets for parking with certain restrictions. Disabled parking permits also serve as a Town parking permit. No permit parking is allowed on trash or snow days.

Some covenants in areas of the Town, including Cotton Ranch, Buckhorn Valley, Chatfield Corners, Sky Legend, Brightwater, Willowstone and Gypsum Estates do not allow on-street parking at any time. Please refer to your covenants if you live in these areas.

Service vehicles are allowed on-street parking, but are subject to the same restrictions on trash and snow days. If you have questions or need further information, please contact Town Hall at 524-7514.

**Utility Bills** - Your bill is mailed the end of the month for the previous month and is due by the 25th. You can drop your utility bill off at Town Hall after hours in the mail slot to the North (left) of the front door entrance. Symbols on the utility bills stand for: WA = water; SW = sewer; TS = trash; IR = irrigation, PE = penalty. Late payments are assessed 1% and will appear under PE.

**Waste Management Recycling** - Containers for recycling are located at the northwest corner of Columbine Market's parking lot. Materials accepted for recycling are: corrugated cardboard, newspapers, aluminum and steel cans, and #1 and #2 plastic containers. Please keep this area clean and free from non-recyclable materials. We are working to expand recycling efforts.

**Water/Sewer** - The Town of Gypsum's drinking water is obtained from Mosher Springs and Gypsum Creek, both supply the entire town with drinking water. Several areas provide their own irrigation water and will be charged a separate rate for it. Because of the quality of Mosher Springs, we are proud there are very few chemicals needed to treat our water. Additional water storage facilities are in process and proposed for future water needs. Please see our website for watering restrictions and watering schedule.

**Irrigation Water** - Some subdivisions in Town have irrigation water for outdoor watering this is non-potable water (don't drink it). This water is billed by the Town; however, the Town does not meter this use. These collected monies go to the HOA management. All questions regarding IR billing on your utility bill should be directed to your HOA representative. If you have irrigation water, you must not use the potable Town water for outdoor purposes.

**Trash Service** - The Town of Gypsum provides \*residential and commercial trash service. Trash is picked up on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Your scheduled pickup day can be verified by calling 970-524-5024. If you prefer, you may contract with another trash service provider.

*\*Town of Gypsum Trash service not available in Buckhorn Valley, Sky Legend, Hardscrabble or Brightwater Subdivisions.*

Some important reminders about Town of Gypsum trash pickup:

- ◆ Trash containers must be the Town of Gypsum issued containers. The 90 gallon residential containers are available for an \$80.00 User Fee. Larger dumpsters are also available and User Fees differ for each.
- ◆ Trash must be placed in the container. Trash left on the ground or that is too large for the container will not be picked up.
- ◆ Lids on the containers must be closed. Trash will not be picked up if the lid is open. It is the homeowner's responsibility to ensure the lid is closed on the designated pickup day.
- ◆ Keep vehicles and other objects from blocking trash containers. Containers must be 3 feet from any object. If the truck is unable to reach the container, it will not get picked up. Our drivers will not get out of the vehicle.
- ◆ No construction (wood, drywall, concrete, etc.) or hazardous materials (paint, oil, etc.) may be placed in container. Motor oil can be recycled at the Town Shop on Cooley Mesa Road.
- ◆ Weeds and grass clippings must be bagged. No tree branches are accepted.
- ◆ Containers must be at the curb by 7:00 a.m. on scheduled pickup day. The arrow on the container lid must point towards the street. Please remove containers from the curb within 24 hours after pickup.
- ◆ Additional trash pickup service is available and will be charged in addition to your monthly fee.
- ◆ Senior citizen trash rates available for 65 and over.

**Town Parks** - The Town is host to many parks and recreation areas. Playground equipment, picnic tables, horseshoe pits, volleyball court, basketball court, baseball fields, public batting cages, seasonal ice rink, and skate park, open playfields, and bike and walking paths,
