


#### Survey Objectives

The objectives of this community survey were to measure and understand Gypsum residents' thoughts and opinions of town services, programs, priorities, and quality of life aspects.







#### Survey Methodology

- Magellan Strategies is pleased to present the results of an online bilingual survey of 467 residents in the Town of Gypsum, CO. The survey data was collected using MMS text messaging and promotion on the town's website and social media. The interviews were conducted from September 7<sup>th</sup>- 21<sup>st</sup>, 2022.
- The overall survey responses have a margin of error of +/- 4.32% at the 95% confidence interval. Population subgroups will have a higher margin of error than the overall sample.
- The survey results were weighted to be representative of the adult population demographics for the Town of Gypsum.

- "Increasing emergency services funding & personnel. (Merging with Eagle River fire, like the rest of the valley.) -Attract more services in town: get rid of Ridleys & get an actual grocery store that takes pride in their product & cleanliness, as well as restaurants, coffee houses, etc., make us a town people want to visit & spend money in, like Eagle or Edwards, not just a gas stop on the highway. Take over the rec center from mtn rec and run it better & more efficiently. You could learn some things from Glenwood. Their rec center & programs are amazing!" -Female, 45-54, Living in Gypsum 6-10 Years
- "Traffic and growth. There is too much growth for our small town. That has also led to too much traffic. Our roads and infrastructure cannot keep up with this."

- Long-term planning and zoning. Gypsum currently lacks a downtown. Traffic. Consider roundabouts for the lighted intersections by the high school. Also, there are way too many offroad vehicles on the streets. Loud and unsafe. -Growth. 

(Ranked by the percentage of respondents indicating excellent or good)






Characteristics as they Relate to Gypsum as a Whole


Satisfaction with Town Services

(Ranked by the percentage of respondents indicating extremely or somewhat satisfied)








How would you rate your level of satisfaction with the following Town services?










How would you rate the speed of new residential housing growth and development in Gypsum for the past five years? Do you think it has been too fast, just the right amount, or too slow?








How would you rate the speed of new retail and commercial growth and development in Gypsum for the past five years? Do you think it has been too fast, just the right amount, or too slow?








Importance of Land Use and Planning Issues

(Ranked by the percentage of respondents that indicated land issue being extremely or very important)





# Thinking now about crime and public safety issues. Do you feel safe living in Gypsum?








Please indicate if you approve or disapprove of the following aspects of public safety in Gypsum.

(Ranked by the percentage of respondents indicating they strongly or somewhat approve)








To what extent are you concerned about the following in the Town of Gypsum and your neighborhood? A 5 means you are very concerned, and a 1 means you are not concerned.

(Ranked by the percentage of respondents who ranked the option #5)












When you commute to work, which of the following modes of transportation do you use? Select all that apply.











How familiar are you with the Town of Gypsum's mosquito mitigation control program?




### Regardless of how familiar you are with the town's mosquito mitigation control program do you support or oppose it?












# Do you, or anyone in your family use the Gypsum Library?








# What could the Gypsum Library do to improve library usage? Select all that apply.







- "Thank you for working to make our town better." -Female, 45-54, Living in Gypsum 20+ Years







#### Gender







Age Range


