AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF GYPSUM, COLORADO AMENDING TITLE 13 OF THE GYPSUM MUNICIPAL CODE TO REPEAL, REMOVE AND DELETE CHAPTER 13.16, NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS

WHEREAS, the Town of Gypsum, Colorado ("Town"), is a home rule municipality of the State of Colorado, duly organized and existing under Article XX of the Colorado Constitution and the Gypsum Home Rule Charter effective October 21, 1982; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 1.3 of the Charter, the Town has all power of local self-government and home rule and all power possible for a home rule municipality to have under the Constitution and laws of the State of Colorado; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has, by Ordinance, adopted Title 13 of the Gypsum Municipal Code ("Code") regarding public services; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 13.16 of the Code relates to the discretionary exemption of nonprofit organizations from the payment of certain water and sewer fees and water rights dedication requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined not to provide such exemptions to nonprofit organizations; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council hereby finds and determines that repealing Chapter 13.16 is appropriate and necessary to the function and operation of the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Gypsum, Colorado that:

- **Section 1.** Amendment of Title 13. Title 13 the Gypsum Municipal Code is hereby amended to repeal, remove and delete Chapter 13.16 in its entirety.
- **Section 2. Public Inspection**. Copies of this Ordinance and the Gypsum Municipal Code are available for public inspection at the office of the Gypsum Town Clerk.
- Section 3. Public Hearing. A public hearing on this Ordinance shall be held on the 10th day of March, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. at the Town of Gypsum Town Hall, 50 Lundgren Boulevard, Gypsum, Colorado.
- Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective as a permanent Ordinance five (5) days after publication, following final adoption after a

public hearing held on the 24th day of March, 2020, at 7:00 p.m., at the Gypsum Town Hall, 50 Lundgren Boulevard, Gypsum, Colorado.

Section 5. Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions.
